Three questions:

Analysis: Question #1 – Hopes

Top responses (5 or more written comments, from 3 or more tables):

- Arts. A stronger emphasis on arts is needed
- **Relationships.** Build trust with community, focusing on transparency and respect
- Leadership. New Council and future GM have opportunity to offer strong leadership
- Vision. More attention should be placed on Island's mission, vision, "spirit" Granville



Analysis: Question #2 – Concerns

- Relationships. Need more trust, transparency and respect
- Management. Management needs to do more to support mission and vision
- **Communications.** Need improved CMHC-tenant communications and engagement
- Leases. A variety of concerns with leases,
 including short terms and onerous
 requirements
 Granville



Question #2 - Concerns (cont...)

- Vision. Island has drifted from its original mission and vision
- Locals/Tourists. The balance has shifted too far towards the tourist visitor
- Empty buildings. Too many vacancies, including former ECUAD





Question #3 –Approaches to Communications and Engagement

- In-person meetings. Provide opportunities for regular face-to-face meetings
- **Email.** The Council should communicate using and be accessible by email
- **Direct consultation.** On topics warranting direct outreach and consultation
- **Documentation.** Council decisions should be publically available
